

Battle of Bautzen

May 22, 1813

Introduction: The Prusso-Russian army was in a full retreat following their defeat at the Battle of Lützen. Finally, generals Wittgenstein and Blücher were ordered to stop at Bautzen by Tsar Alexander I and König Frederick William III. The Prusso-Russian army was nearly 100,000 men strong, but Napoleon had 115,000 troops. Additionally, Marshal Ney had 85,000 more men within easy marching distance. Due to faulty reconnaissance, Napoleon became concerned that the Prusso-Russians had more soldiers and held stronger positions than they actually did. So Napoleon then decided he would not set up his trap until they had been softened up. The first day's fighting pushed the allies back away from the Bautzen and the Spree River. On the following day, the 21st, was again hard fighting but after several hours of setbacks, renewed French attacks began to gain momentum. These assaults were only intended to fix the allies in place so they could be cut off and enveloped. Once again, Marshal Ney became distracted and decided to seize the village of Preititz, and thus lost sight of the strategic importance of cutting off the allies.

The Prusso-Russians were being pushed back and, at 4 PM, when the Imperial Guard was sent in, began an all-out retreat. Without Ney's forces to seal them in, however, they again escaped the total defeat Napoleon had planned. Losses on both sides totaled around 20,000. But some other sources also say that the losses on French side were significantly higher because of their aggressive attack tactics which failed to cut off the allies from their lines and the allies only lost 11,000 - 14,000.

Scale: Each stand represents 360 Infantry, 180 cavalry or 6 to 12 cannon. Ground scale is 120 yards per inch, while each turn is 30 minutes of real time.

Players: Anywhere between 2-12 players.

Terrain and Weather: The gaming table is 12 feet by 6 feet. Weather is clear. Woods and Urban Area are rough ground for movement. Urban areas and redoubts grant a -2/+2 DRM advantage to defenders for fire and melee. Woods provide a -1/+1 DRM advantage to defenders for Fire and Melee. Hill slopes provide a +1 melee DRM for the defender for higher ground. The Spree River is unfordable and can only be crossed at bridges and fords (light blue rectangles). The other rivers count as streams for movement and can be crossed and forded as normal (Page 14 in AoE). The bright blue circles represent carp ponds. These are impassable to artillery, and very rough ground for infantry and cavalry (1/3 movement), and also disorder any unit charging through them.

Playing Time: The game begins at the 8:00 am turn and ends with the 6:00 pm turn, a total of 21 turns.

Deployment: Units set up per the accompanying map, the Allies deploy first. Brigades are deployed in Lines, Supported Lines or Brigade Masse while artillery sets up limbered or unlimbered, but must deploy as depicted or no more than 12 inches away from a leader stand

within their chain of command. Leaders deploy within 12 inches of any unit from their command. 39/III is road column. While not shown on the map the Allied army have 10 redoubts for their artillery, these may be deployed as the Allied CinC sees fit, no more than 3 redoubts per Corp. Players may place units in town sectors that their Corps are attached to on the game map.

Initiative & Leaders: Roll for initiative at the beginning of each turn. Napoleon, if unattached has a +2 DRM. Wittgenstein, if unattached has a -1 DRM. Ney is a Wing Commander, besides III Corp commander, and can add his leadership benefit to any unit in II, III, V, VII Corp. Soult is a Wing Commander and may add his leadership benefit to any unit not under Ney's Command. Blücher may add his leadership benefit to any Prussian unit. Blücher is charismatic.

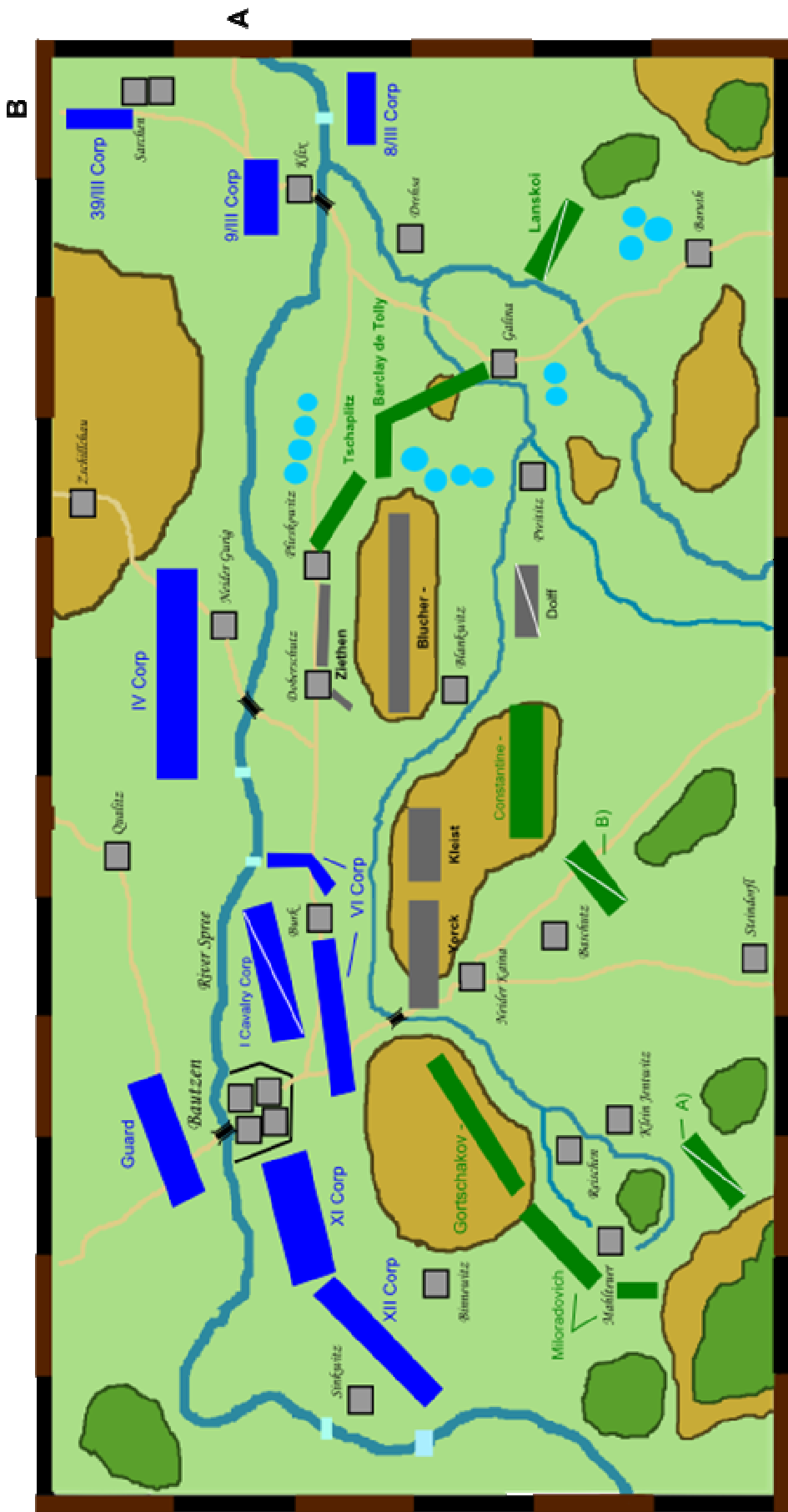
Troop Quality: All Infantry are Columnar Infantry, except the Old Guard which are Impulse Infantry. Units with Skirmishers are so noted.

Reinforcements: As listed on each army's OoB. All units enter in Road/March Column at the Point Location on the map. If there is not enough physical space for all units scheduled to arrive to enter the table, they are considered "backed up" off table and may automatically enter next turn. Use the Reinforcement Table on page 16 of AoE to vary arrival times, for a more intense optional game.

Special Rules: The Facing to Flank and Urban Combat rules are in effect from the *Age of Eagles (AoE) Supplement* (found online). Each building model will support six infantry or artillery stands.

Special Rules "Decisions, Decisions": It was Napoleon's intention that Ney move around the Allies right flank and gain control of the roads leading to Weissenberg. Ney though, got too focused on the fighting for Preititz and didn't maneuver as Napoleon planned. Given free reign the player(s) controlling Ney and his forces might have a more significant impact on the battle than they did historically. To better represent Ney's historical actions in the game, until the town of Preititz is in French control (including by Ney's troops) no unit under Ney's command may move further east or south of Preititz's location.

Victory Conditions: Determine victory using the Casualty Point Chart on page 17 of AoE. If the French player(s) control the road exits between points C and D at the game's end any worn or spent Allied brigades still on the map count double for VPs. If Napoleon is killed during the battle the French player(s) automatically lose and have to sing any Rihanna song for the Allied players' amusement. (Ideally "We found Love")
