

Battle of Wagram

July 6th, 1809

Introduction: After the setback at Aspern-Essling, Napoleon began a methodical and safer crossing of the Danube River. After a month of impressive construction on Lobau Island, starting on July 4th, the Grand Armee once again crossed the river. On the evening of the 5th the French advance guard launched an attack on the Austrians, the latter managing to hold on to their positions. Charles planned a bold double envelopment of Napoleon, considering he was outnumbered and severely in cavalry. The plan had little chance of success though, the length of the battlefield, poor staff work and delays in Prince John's reinforcements, all undermined Charles' efforts. The battle was a bloodbath, the generally open ground and large numbers of artillery on both sides resulted in extremely heavy casualties. The Austrian attacks on their left were contained by Davout and he quickly began his own attack. Against Bernadotte's corp on the other side they quickly seized Aderklaa and forced the IX Corp back. The Austrian III and VI Corp attacks against Massena's IV Corp threatened to break through but lacking support and far from Charles, they quickly lost steam and were halted. Napoleon massed a grand battery of 112 guns and forced the Austrian advance back. Napoleon ordered the Army of Italy to retake Aderklaa, but Austrian massed artillery caused heavy losses and stopped the attack. Davout's attack though was breaking through the Austrian left threatening to roll up the line. Realizing his plan had failed Charles ordered a retreat. Despite large numbers of cavalry, the French forces were exhausted and no pursuit began for over a day.

Scale: Each stand represents 360 Infantry, 180 cavalry or 6 to 12 cannon. Ground scale is 120 yards per inch, while each turn is 30 minutes of real time.

Players: Anywhere between 2-12 players.

Terrain and Weather: The gaming table is larger "L" shaped 12 feet by 9 feet. Weather is clear and warm. Woods, Marsh and Urban Areas are rough ground for movement. Urban areas grant a -2/+2 DRM advantage to defenders for fire and melee. Woods provide a -1/+1 DRM advantage to defenders for Fire and Melee. Slopes provide a +1 DRM advantage to Melee only. The stream can be forded normally.

Playing Time: The game begins at the 6:00 am and ends with the 3:00 pm turn, a total of 19 turns.

Deployment: Units set up per the accompanying map, the French set up first. Brigades are deployed in Lines, Supported Lines or Brigade Masse while artillery sets up limbered or unlimbered, but must deploy as no more than 12 inches away from a leader stand within their

chain of command. Corp reserve artillery may deploy with any unit in that corp, no more than two batteries per brigade. Charles' Army Reserve artillery can set up anywhere with I, II or IV Corp. Leaders deploy within 12 inches of any unit from their command.

Initiative & Leaders: Roll for initiative at the beginning of each turn. Napoleon, if unattached has a +3 DRM. Charles if unattached has a +1 DRM. Napoleon, Lasalle, Charles and Nostitz are Charismatic Leaders.

Troop Quality: The French Guard, French III Corp and Marion's Brigade (II Corp) are Impulse Infantry. The Saxons are Linear Infantry. All other infantry is Columnar. Skirmish capable troops are noted on their labels.

Reinforcements: As listed on each army's OoB. All units enter deployed at the Area Location on the map. Troops may enter road/column if the player wishes. If there is not enough physical space for all units scheduled to arrive to enter the table, they are considered "backed up" off table and may automatically enter next turn. Use the Reinforcement Table on page 16 of AOE to vary arrival times, for a more intense optional game.

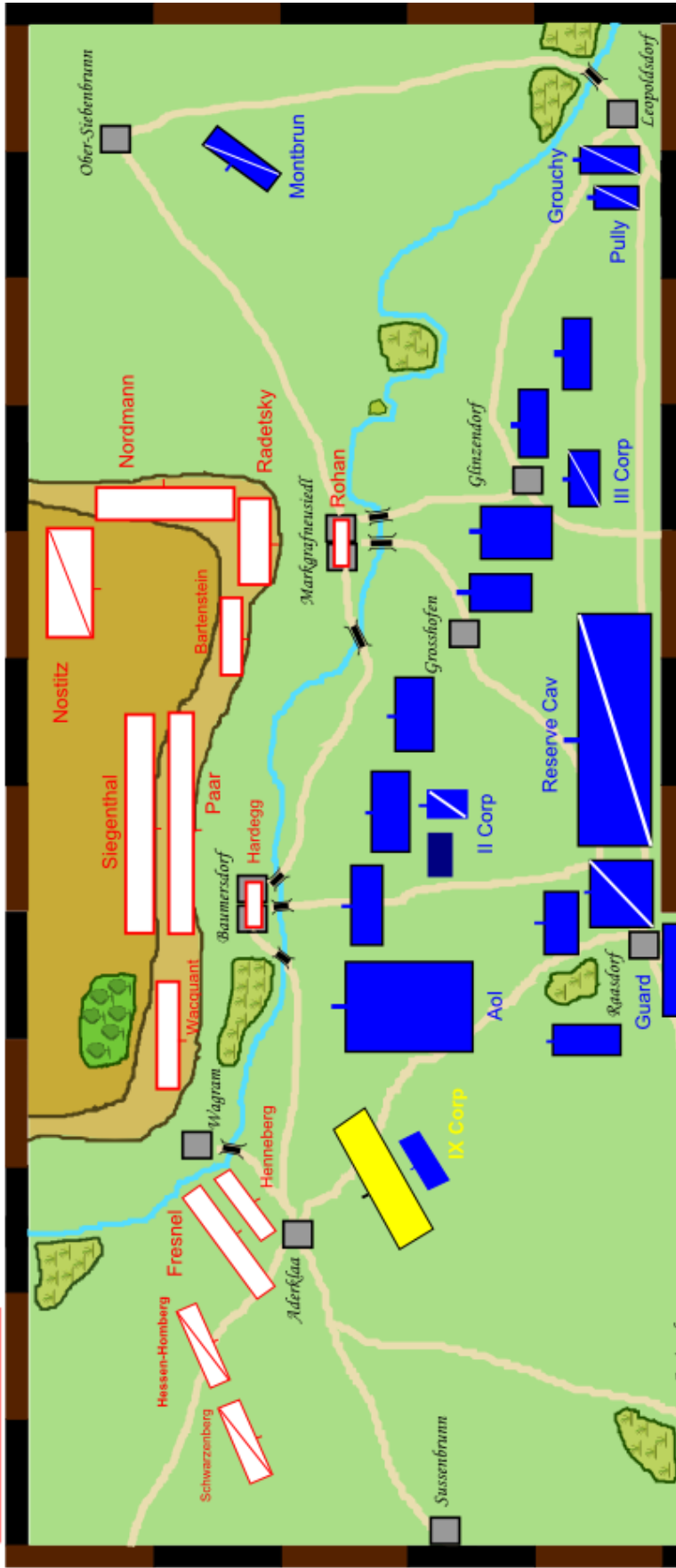
Special Rules: The Facing to Flank and Urban Combat rules are in effect from the *Age of Eagles (AoE) Supplement* (found online). Each building model will support six infantry or artillery stands.

Optional Rules *Prince John Arrives on time:* On Turn 5 Prince John's Army of the Inner Austria arrive anywhere on the eastern table north of the stream. This option costs the Austrians 10 VPs.

Victory Conditions: Determine victory using the Casualty Point Chart on page 17 of AOE.
